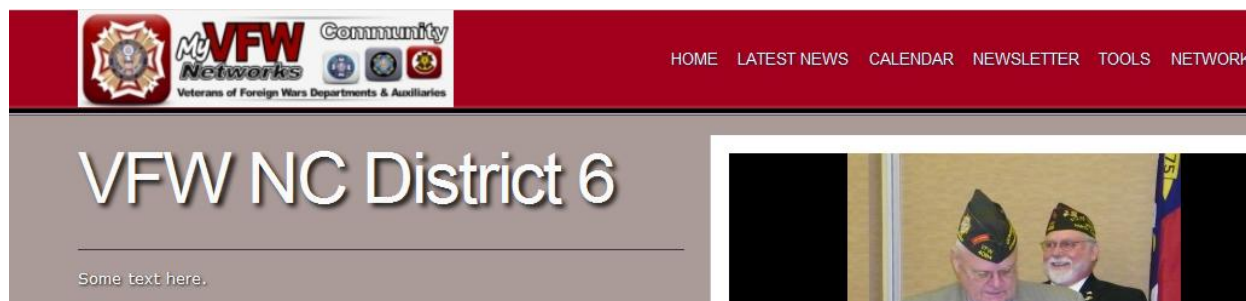

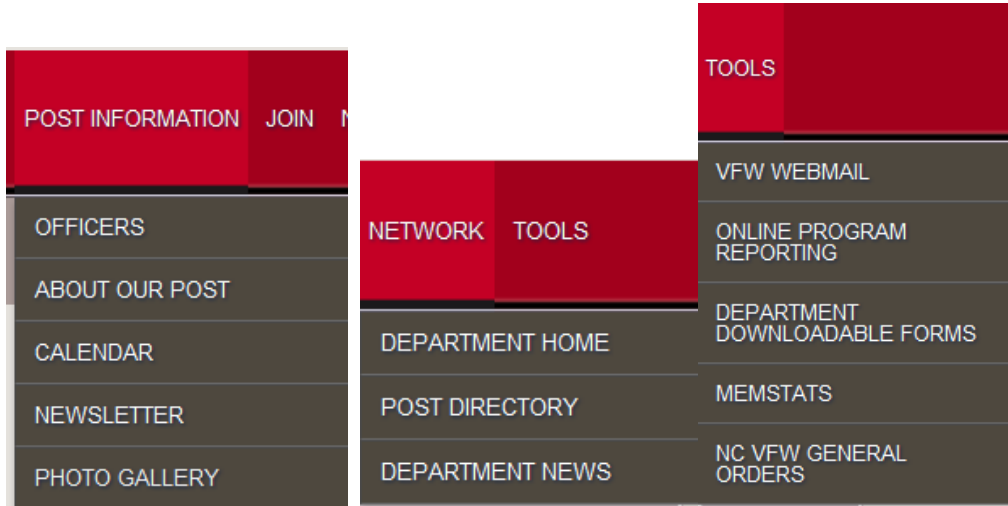

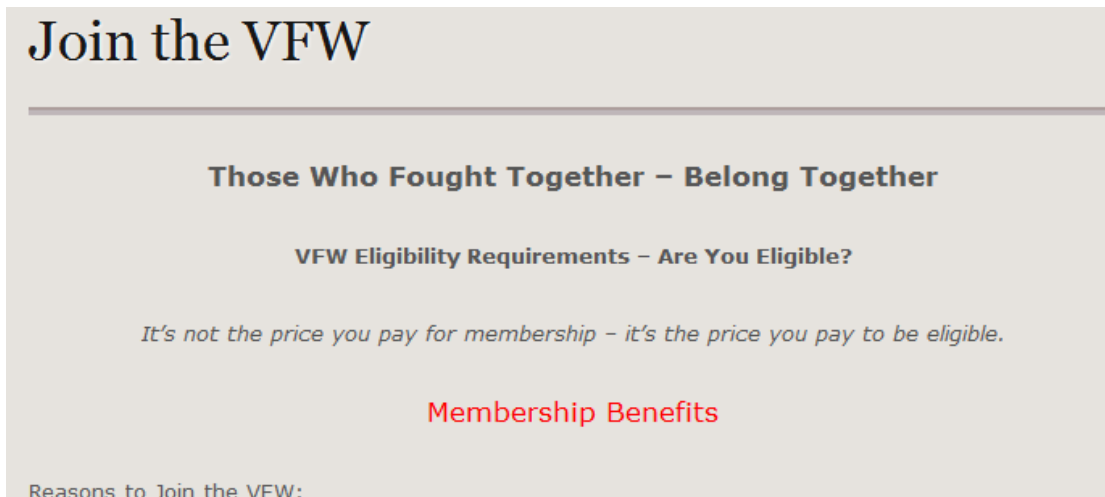
Note the icon options. Hover over icon for description of service.

Edit, enlarge, or reduce photos. Size photos for web use. Email photos in smaller size and save bandwidth. Create slideshows and movies. Adjust color, crop, frame, straighten, and sort photos.



1. Send photos for printing. Get 6 cent 3x6 prints on Tuesdays/Wednesdays at RitzPix.
2. Get posters made. Many companies participate.
3. Upload photos to Google Web Album and share photos.

## The other Google tools



Mail, telephone service like Skype, video conferencing, video sharing, a Google web site or blog, and Google Apps.



If you have Google and Google Apps, you never need Microsoft Office to open or edit documents while you are in email. You no longer have to download attachments to your computer and then open with a special program. View email anywhere or by Smartphone. Upload photos and share files with post officers.

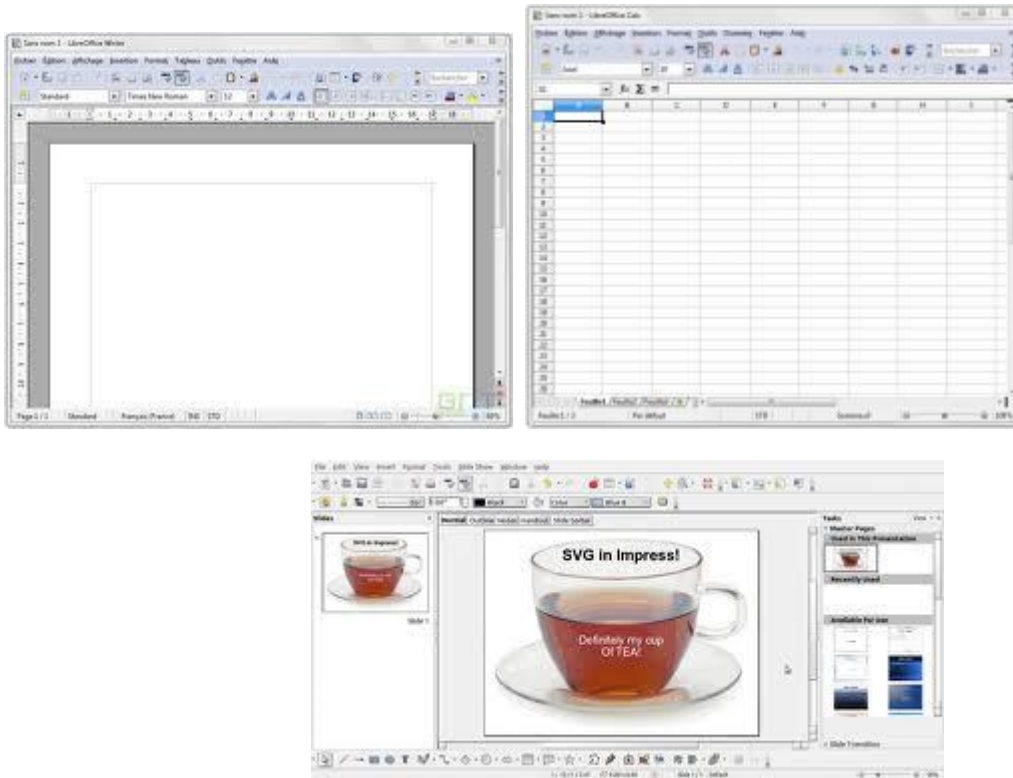


**An Office Suite to replace Microsoft Office with no cost to the user!**
