

JCM Fund Targets SUICIDE Alternate TREATMENT Psychiatric Service Dogs

PLEASE Help the 1SG John Champion Memorial Assistance Dog Fund provide Psychiatric Service Dogs to Veterans and Active-duty Service Members, so other families don't have to go through this.



1SG Champion served three combat tours in Iraq and Afghanistan along with Haiti, Rwanda, Darfur, Bosnia and Kosovo. He was the Commander of VFW Post 2401 and a member of the American Legion.

1SG Champion was also diagnosed with Chronic/Complex Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder. On July 6th, 2009, 1SG Champion, age 41, tragically put a rifle in his mouth and pulled the trigger., thus taking his own life, inside VFW Post 2401, to escape the ravages and symptoms of his combat-related Chronic / Complex Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).



Mrs. Cece Miller, 1SG Champion's sister:

"In 2009 my family and I went through what no family wants to endure, the suicide of my bother. After 21 year in the Army, he simply could not deal with his PTSD any longer."

"I founded the John R. Champion Memorial Assistance Dog Fund, with the assistance of the paws4people foundation, to help those like my bother with Chronic / Complex PTSD and TBI by providing them with Psychiatric Service Dogs."

"As a certified Assistance Dog trainer, I have witnessed first-hand the effect and power this dogs have with Veterans and Active-duty Service Members, like my brother. I only wish John could have had an opportunity to have such a dog."
